Discussion about potential improvements to Bert Reel Park

- The committee discussed potential improvements to the baseball field, walking trail and basketball court of Bert Reel Park with township engineer Jamie MacCombie. The committee learned about the benefits and maintenance associated with certain walking trail materials, and also learned about certain drainage issues concerning the baseball field. The committee agreed that the best way to move forward would be to survey the township residents about the park facilities before making any recommendation to the Board of Supervisors.

Old business

1. Thanks to the support of the community, the BBQ held in Bert Reel Park brought in \$684. After \$188.64 in costs, the total amount raised came to \$495.36.
2. Mr Jessey reported he had sent out letters to local businesses in order to solicit sponsorship for Community Day.
3. Mr Jessey reported that due to the lack of volunteers and inclement weather, there had been no Snack Shack activity in June.
4. Mr Jessey reported that the township had approved a banner design for Community Day, and that he had sent an email to the company who has been doing the banners.
